## Centenary Stages 5<sup>th</sup> August 2007 FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

**Thank you for your entry and welcome to Twyford Wood. Your competition number is shown on the attached entry list. The start time of car "0" will be 0830. Individual ATC times will be published on the official notice board by 1630 on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup>. There will be a competitor briefing at 0800 on Sunday.**

**Entry into the venue is only permitted as shown on the attached map. Please follow the published route to the service area, all trailers must be left in the trailer park. Due to space limitations, only vehicles with service area parking permits will be allowed into the service area, only one service vehicle per competitor, all other vehicles with passes may be parked in the auxiliary parking area next to the trailer park. Please be aware that all competitors are responsible for their service crew and guests and penalties will be applied for misconduct in and around the venue (SR 15(b) applies). At the request from Lincolnshire police parking penalties will be applied for cars parked on the main road outside the venue. Parking in the venue will be monitored and penalties applied for infringements. Extra parking permits may be purchased at the venue, all proceeds to Multiple Sclerosis Charity (SR 21 applies). YOU MUST SHOW A PASS TO GAIN ENTRY TO THE VENUE.**

**The gates to the venue will be opened at 1500 and closed at 2000 and also 2200 – 2230 prompt on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> August, and at 0600 – 0800 on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup>. The gate may also be opened during the lunch break to allow exit from the venue. There will be no other vehicular access to and from the venue during the competition.**

**Noise check and scrutineering will take place on Saturday between 1600 and 1900 prompt, and again from 0630 on Sunday. Documentation will be open at the same time. All competitors are reminded to have correct documentation and the correct competition licence. The rally plate provided should be affixed to the back window and kept clean at all times.**

All competitors are reminded that there is no fuel or water available at the venue; please ensure you have sufficient for your own needs. The nearest fuel and water can be found at the services on A1/A151 roundabout at Colsterworth, approx ½ mile from the venue as shown on the venue map.

Any unauthorised practice or receiving in or on a motorised vehicle by any competitor or their associated personnel will result in immediate exclusion. Officials will be in attendance on the Saturday night. Walking or cycling the stage is allowed. For safety reasons, the use of any powered pit bike is strictly forbidden on the venue. Again, if any crewmember or associated personnel are observed using such a machine the crew will be excluded.

#### Amendment to Supplementary Regulations

SR 15a Shortcutting, whether an advantage is gained or not – stage maximum.

The awards presentation will be conducted on the venue at rally HQ as soon as possible following completion of the competition.

It is a requirement of the Forestry Commission that there be no open fires on the venue. Please exercise extreme caution when using BBQ's and ensure a fire extinguisher is at hand.

**PLEASE TAKE ALL RUBBISH HOME WITH YOU.**
