



TELBROOK ENGINEERING MALLORY PARK SPRINT

ORGANISED BY SHEFFIELD AND HALLAMSHIRE MOTOR CLUB SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Sheffield and Hallamshire Motor Club will organise a National 'A'/B' sprint on Sunday 6th September 2009 at Mallory Park Race Circuit Leicester
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provision of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA Permit Nat A/B No TBA has been issued
4. **Championship and Eligibility:** the event is a round of the 2009 SBD British Championship (CHS2009/006) and is open to contenders in the SBD British Sprint Championship and includes the Junior Challenge contenders, and the following invited clubs: - any MSA registered motor club.
5. **Licences:** Competitors must produce valid and appropriate competition licences and club member/championship cards.
6. **The Course:** The course is approximately 2 miles long (1.75 Laps), on tarmac, with left and right hand corners. The start will be from the pit lane exit and the finish will be denoted by chequered boards just before Edwina's (after 1.75 laps). All competitors will be given the opportunity of 2 practice and 2 timed runs each, time and weather permitting.
A Top12 run off for the SBD British Sprint Championship contenders will be held at the end of the kart racing (SBD British Championship 24.1)
7. **The programme of the meeting will be:**

All vehicles must be in the paddock by 8.00 hrs as the gate closes at 8.00 hrs

Signing on Starts 7.30 am **Any competitor not signed on by 9.00 am may be excluded**

Scrutineering starts at 7.30 am

Drivers Briefing will take place at 8.30 am

1st Practice

Run to follow Karts Free Practice 3 at 10.06 hrs

2nd Practice

Run to follow Karts Timed Practice 3 at 11.49 hrs

1st Timed Run Immediately After Lunch 13.15 hrs approx
2nd Timed Run To follow Kart race 3 15.22 hrs approx
Top 12 Run Off To follow Kart Race 6 17.30 hrs approx
All times are Approximate.

8. **The Event** will consist of classes as follows: -

Division A – Road Cars (Saloons and Sports cars running road tyres)

Division B – Modified Cars (Saloon and Sport cars)

Division C – Competition Cars (Sport Libre and Racing cars Nat 'B')

Division D – Competition Cars (All SBD British Sprint Championship Contenders)

Individual Class will be notified in the final instructions.

9. **Practice and Starting:** Competitors will be permitted to walk the course before 8.15 am and will be given the opportunity of two Practice Runs time and weather permitting; Practice runs need not be timed. Starting order will be determined by number order. Cars will start singly. The start signal will be green light. A red light indicates that the course is not open. Timing struts are compulsory L10.9.1.
10. **Numbers:** Competitors will be identified by numbers allocated, but not supplied in accordance with I.30. Numbers must be displayed on both sides of the car at all times, double entered cars it's the competitors responsibility for ensuring the correct number is displayed at all times.
11. **Tyre Warming:** There will be NO tyre warming at this event.
12. **Noise:** All cars must comply with C(b).24
13. The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations and closes finally on Monday 31st August 2009. There will be maximum 100 with no minimum numbers. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the £140 entry fee. **Cheques payable to Sheffield and Hallamshire Motor Club Ltd.** Entry fees may be refunded up to mid-day Wednesday 2nd September 2009, less an administration fee of £30.
